

Our goal is to remain open and to provide a high quality of care during the upcoming flu season. We ask that you keep your child home from daycare/school if they are sick to minimize the spread of the illness. Staff has been advised to remain home as well when ill.

Our centre will close only if licensing requirements cannot be met or the province/school division mandates a closure. Any school/childcare closure for this centre will be announced on CJOB radio.

Your child's health and safety is important to us and with your cooperation, we can help reduce the spread of illness. Please ensure you have alternate care available should your child develop flu like symptoms while at daycare/school. It is also important to ensure our contact information is up to date so we can reach you quickly.

We are practicing good health/hygiene routines within the centre and are teaching the children to cover their cough, wash their hands frequently and to cover their sneezes.
